

# Acrylic Gloss White Baths

## Product Care Guide

### Pre-installation Checks

- Unpack and inspect the item. Make sure that the item is correct and that no damage has occurred during transit. If you find any visible defects, do not proceed with installation. Instead, contact the retailer immediately. Any claims for damage after installation will not be accepted.
- Protect your bath. During and after installation, take steps to protect your bath from scratches, cracks, and other surface damage. Such damage is not covered by the warranty.
- Install in accordance with regulations. The installation must be in accordance with an applicable building regulations and local authority requirements.

- Vinegar Solution: For a natural cleaning solution, mix equal parts white vinegar and water in a spray bottle, spray the tub, and let it sit for a few minutes before scrubbing and rinsing.
- Rinse thoroughly.
- After cleaning, always rinse the tub thoroughly with clean water to remove any soap residue.
- Do not use powders, pastes, creams, chemicals, window cleaning sprays or abrasive cleaners.
- Cream cleaners can only be used to remove stubborn marks but do so with caution as they may scratch the bath.

### Caring for Your Bath

- Once your bath has been installed, fill the bathtub with cold water to allow the bath to gradually adapt to the temperature.
- After using the bathtub, clean it with a soft cloth and warm, soapy water. This will remove any oil or soap and prevent tide marks from forming.
- Note: Epsom salts are safe to use in acrylic baths and will not cause any product defects. Ensure the bath is rinsed thoroughly with water after use.

### Cleaning Advice & Advice for Scratches & Stains

- Soap Residue/Everyday stains: For general cleaning, use a solution of mild dish soap and warm water using a soft sponge. Rinse with water and wipe dry.
- Baking Soda Paste: For stubborn stains, create a paste with baking soda and water, apply it to the stained areas, and let it sit for a few minutes before scrubbing with a soft sponge or cloth.
