Basins, Slab Tops & Baths

Stonecast basins, baths and slab tops are constructed by skilfully combining natural minerals with high performance resins to construct a strong, beautiful material with unique properties. StoneCast products are capable of being moulded into intricate & precise designs, where traditional materials are limited.

Gloss White Finish

1. For daily care simply use a non-abrasive cleaning product or a mild dish soap and warm water solution.
2. After each use, rinse the inside of your basin or bath with water and wipe dry with a soft cotton cloth.
3. To maintain the product aesthetics and help prevent stains, a beeswax polish can be applied once a month to form a protective barrier.
4. To remove stubborn stains such as grease, mildew, oil, paint or ink stains, use warm water with either a gentle cleaning product or soap solution.
5. Abrasive cleaners should never be used on StoneCast Gloss White basin or baths. If a product feels gritty when rubbed between your fingers, it is not safe to use on gloss finishes.
6. Small scratches can be removed by using a fine paste.
7. Limescale can be treated with a solution of water and white vinegar.

Important Care Instructions – Heat Damage Warning

Do not place any hot objects, such as hair straighteners, directly onto your Stonecast product. Exposure to high temperatures can cause discoloration, burns, cracks, and irreversible damage.

We recommend using a heat-resistant mat for any hot appliance or object; however, please note that this does not guarantee the product will remain undamaged.

Any heat-related damage to your Stonecast product will not be covered under warranty.

GENERAL CLEANING TIPS

DO NOT use cleaning pads with abrasive surfaces as this will scratch the Gloss Finish.
