Daily Care: Keep It Simple

The best way to maintain your tapware is with consistent, gentle cleaning. Use a soft damp cloth to wipe away fingerprints, soap residue, and water spots after use. A quick daily wipe-down helps prevent build-up and keeps finishes looking crisp.

Where possible, dry the tapware after cleaning to prevent limescale deposits forming from hard water. This is especially helpful in areas where water tends to pool around the base of the mixer or spout.

Avoid hanging damp towels, facecloths, or sponges over your taps. Prolonged moisture exposure can affect the finish, especially on PVD surfaces.



For a Deeper Clean

For a more thorough clean, use a mild soap solution, such as a drop of liquid dishwashing detergent diluted in warm water, applied with a soft sponge or microfibre cloth. This gently lifts grease, residue, and light mineral deposits without damaging the surface. Rinse thoroughly with clean water and dry with a soft cloth to avoid water spots. There's no need for harsh chemicals or abrasive tools; in fact, avoiding them helps preserve both the look and lifespan of your tapware.



Routine Checks

Regularly clean aerators to avoid mineral build-up affecting water flow.



Understand Your Tapware Finish

Different finishes benefit from slightly different care approaches. For example, the Evoke/Motivo Tapware range by Newtech includes a variety of surface finishes, each with its own characteristics:

✓ **Chrome (Mirror Chrome)**

A high-shine finish that's easy to clean but shows water spots and fingerprints readily. It responds well to a soft cloth and a mild, pH-neutral cleaner. Avoid scouring pads or powders, which can scratch the surface.

✓ **Black Chrome (Electroplated)**

This dark, satin finish offers a sleek look and good resistance to fingerprints. As an electroplated finish, black chrome is more sensitive than it appears; avoid any abrasive cleaners, acidic products, or rough sponges to preserve its shine.

✓ **Gunmetal and Brushed Brass (PVD)**

Both these finishes are applied using PVD (Physical Vapour Deposition), a process that bonds colour to the surface for improved durability. Despite their resilience, these finishes can still be affected by harsh cleaners or abrasive tools. Use only gentle liquid or cream cleansers and a soft cloth. Avoid bleach, acidic solutions, or anything abrasive.

✓ **Brushed Nickel (Brushed Stainless Steel)**

These finishes offer a softer, matte appearance and do a good job of concealing marks. To clean, follow the direction of the brush lines using a soft cloth. Harsh scrubbing across the grain can cause fine surface damage.

Quadro Tapware:

✓ **Chrome, Black and Gunmetal (Electroplated)**

This satin finish offers a sleek look and good resistance to fingerprints. As an electroplated finish, is more sensitive than it appears; avoid any abrasive cleaners, acidic products, or rough sponges to preserve its shine.

✓ **Brushed Nickel and Brushed Brass (PVD)**

Both these finishes are applied using PVD (Physical Vapour Deposition), a process that bonds colour to the surface for improved durability. Despite their resilience, these finishes can still be affected by harsh cleaners or abrasive tools. Use only gentle liquid or cream cleansers and a soft cloth.
