

How to Remove your Tap Aerator

An aerator is a small mesh screen located at the tip of the tap spout that mixes air into the water stream. This helps reduce water usage, prevent splashing, and create a smooth, consistent flow. Over time, mineral deposits and debris can build up in the aerator, restricting water flow and affecting performance. Regular cleaning is recommended to maintain optimal water pressure and hygiene.



Step by Step Guides

Using the Aerator Removal Tool

Applies to: Evoke Basin Mixers, Evoke Wall Mounted Basin Mixer & Bath Spout, Evoke Freestanding Bath Filler, Motivo Basin Mixers, Motivo Wall Mounted Basin Mixer, Quadro Kitchen Sink Mixer

1. **Identify the Aerator** – Locate the aerator at the tip of the tap spout.
2. **Select the Correct Tool** – Use the correct-sized aerator tool (included in the tap box) that matches your tap model.
3. **Insert the Tool** – Gently insert the tool into the aerator, ensuring it grips securely.
4. **Twist to Loosen** – Turn the tool counterclockwise to unscrew the aerator. Avoid excessive force.
5. **Remove the Aerator** – Finish unscrewing by hand and remove.
6. **Clean or Replace** – Rinse thoroughly or replace if damaged.
7. **Reinstall** – Screw back in by hand, turning clockwise. Do not overtighten

Without Aerator Tool

Applies to: Evoke Gooseneck Sink Mixers, Motivo Gooseneck Sink Mixer, Quadro Basin Mixers, Quadro Wall Mounted Basin Mixer, Quadro Bath Spout

1. **Identify the Aerator** – Locate the aerator at the tip of the tap spout.
2. **Wrap the Spout Tip** – Use a soft cloth to protect the finish.
3. **Use Soft-Jawed Pliers** – Or wrap regular pliers with cloth and gently grip the aerator.
4. **Twist Counterclockwise** – Slowly unscrew. Use steady pressure.
5. **Remove the Aerator** – Finish unscrewing by hand and remove.
6. **Clean or Replace** – Rinse thoroughly or replace if damaged.
7. **Reinstall** – Screw back in by hand, turning clockwise. Do not overtighten
