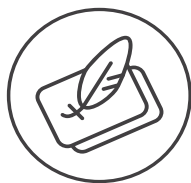


Painted Baths

Care Guide & Warranty Information

Please take the time to read through the Care Guide and Warranty Information which covers everyday cleaning recommendations for your new painted acrylic bath.

Your acrylic bath exterior has been finished with a two-pack exterior grade Polyurethane in a satin finish, offering excellent protection against high humidity areas. We do however recommend that you follow the cleaning recommendations to preserve the condition of the painted exterior.



Cleaning Recommendations

Clean your painted bath exterior by wiping over it with a cloth dampened with warm water and a touch of dishwashing liquid. Dust using a soft dry cloth or feather duster.

DO NOT

- DO NOT interfere with the painted bath edge, as this can be easily chipped.
- DO NOT use any abrasive cleaners like “Jiff” or strong citrus based cleaners as these will polish the low sheen surface.
- DO NOT use abrasive cleaners or “spray and wipe” solutions.
- DO NOT use furniture polishes containing silicones.
- DO NOT leave liquid spillages on horizontal surfaces or dripping down on vertical faces.
- DO NOT place any hot appliances directly onto painted surfaces.
- DO NOT allow finger nail polishes and removers, personal deodorants, perfumes, after shave lotions, soaps, etc. to come into contact with the painted surfaces.
- DO NOT drop or throw sharp or heavy objects against the painted surfaces.
- DO NOT use excessive force to remove stubborn dirt, grease, etc. especially on the painted finish.

Warranty Conditions

- Your new painted bath comes with a 2-year warranty on manufacturing faults, providing all care recommendations and instructions have been followed. Manufacturing faults include paint blistering, falling off or cracked paint.
- Wear and tear or damage caused by cleaning with harsh chemicals will NOT be covered under warranty. Please take care during installation as scratches incurred during this time will not be covered.
